

2022 NASP® Eastern Nationals

Kentucky Exposition Center – May 12 - 14, 2022

LOCATION

- 1. Kentucky Fair & Exposition Center, Louisville, Kentucky @ www.kyfairexpo.org
- 2. Parking: \$8 per entry for cars and \$20 for buses
- 3. Admission Adults \$10, Youth 13-18 \$5, and 12 and under is free. Keep entry wrist strap because admission covers all 3 days of event. (Registered archers & coaches are free.)
- 4. Food & Beverage sold on site -- KEC does not allow carry in or coolers inside building.
- 5. Registration fee: \$35/archer (3 coaches free/team...1 coach free/individual group) due by May 6th!
- 6. Tournament Hotels: To be announced at www.nasptournaments.org & www.naspschools.org/events/

Special Note: For 2022 and beyond archers will be required to provide their own arrows at National level events. NASP® will no longer supply arrows at national level tournaments.

Shirts – will be shipped directly to the schools

- ***New for 2022 National tournament shirts will now be shipped directly to the schools.
- Shirt shipping information will be entered as part of registration.
- Coach shirt sizes will be entered as part of registration.
- The number of coach shirts is dependent on the number of teams/groups for a school
- This must be a school or business address. Residential addresses are not allowed.
- If an incorrect address is entered the registering coach will be responsible for the cost of reshipping the shirts

Pre-Registration: Monday, March 14th @ 8AM - Sunday April 10th @ 5PM EST

- ***New for 2022 National registration will use a new Auto Flight Selection process.
 - The Auto Flight Selection process will run between the end of pre-registration and the start of full registration.
 - During pre-registration schools will pick flight preferences.
 - Flights will be auto selected for each school based on tiers and flight preferences entered during pre-registration.
 - Each school will have an opportunity to review selected flights before full registration and change/add/drop flights during full registration if needed and as space permits.
 - Schools will be financially responsible for all flight positions assigned and not dropped by the drop by date.
 - The Auto Flight Selection process will assign all archers to the NASP® bullseye flights first. It
 will then assign archers to the NASP®-IBO 3D flights ensuring that there is a minimum of one
 flight spacing between flight times for Bullseye and 3D flight times.

- Only schools that select flight preferences during pre-registration will receive flight selections during
 the auto-flight selection. It is critical that a school selects ALL flight times that they are willing to
 accept.
- All pre-registered Individual qualifiers (top 10 in the State Tournament) but will be guaranteed a
 position and assigned to a flight position. The flight time assigned may not be one of your
 preferred/selected times.
 - Individual qualifiers registered as part of a team group (elem/middle/high) do not need to be registered as individuals
 - o Individual qualifiers registered as part of a team group (elem/middle/high) will be assigned a flight position.
 - If your individual qualifier is placed and your team is not, it is the coach's responsibility to remove the individual qualifiers registration before registration closes.

NASP® National registration protocols for Eastern national:

- A qualified team (school/division) may register to participate in one but not both Western and Eastern National
- A qualified individual may register to participate in one but not both Western and Eastern National.
- Individual scores from one event cannot be added to a team score from another event

Registration: Access opens April 13th by tier to edit your flights that were auto selected. Registration closes at 8pm EST on April 14th.

April 13 (11:00 AM EST) **Guaranteed Placement:** 1st-10th place individuals by division & gender. Individual qualifiers **MUST be pre-registered** for guaranteed placement.

April 13 (1:00 PM EST)

Tier 4: Team scores greater than 2,799 (Elementary), 3,149 (Middle), and 3,249 (High)

Tier 5: Team scores greater than 2,649 (Elementary), 3,099 (Middle), and 3,199 (High)

April 13 (1:30 PM EST)

Tier 6: Team scores greater than 2,499 (Elementary), 2,999 (Middle), and 3,099 (High)

April 14 (1PM EST) **DROP BY DATE/TIME**...deadline to drop flight positions. You are responsible to pay registration for all flight positions you registered at this time.

The Academic Archer indicator box must be checked on the National Tournament registration, for All-Academic Team eligibility. **We assign this responsibility of cross checking the archer's AA status to the teacher or coach.**

^{**} Once registration closes on April 14th, you are responsible to submit payment by May 6th for all archers you had registered on April 14th.

^{***} Changes after registration closes must be addressed on site one hour or more before your flight time.

^{****}No archer or team is guaranteed participation at NATIONALS. When flights fill the tournament closes.
